Inspector Mark Thomas reported the following to members –

Blackwood crime figures show a 6.1% decrease on the same period last year, this representing 12 less victims over the comparison period.

Anti Social Behaviour figures showed a 11.2% increase on the same period lat year, the majority of the increase relating to problems around the Cliff Road area during the Easter school holidays, and represented an additional 14 ASB calls over the comparison period.

Over the past 3 months, the Neighbourhood Policing Team had –

Increased patrols around Cliff Road to reduce ASB and this has been successful Worked with retailers to try and prevent theft of alcohol by youths from stores Townsafe Patrols have continued with a deterrent effect and low numbers arrested 4 Section 27 Direction to leave warnings have been issued over the past month to move people from the town for 48 hours

1 Youth has been issued with an ABC

Cruiser Op took place one Thursday night, however, it was relatively quiet that night Roads Policing Unit have been spending more time on the By Pass to deal with speeding Carried out engagement work during the Beach Party, and were joined by the Crime Prevention Panel an a Police Cadet. An additional 205 residents were signed up for OWL Test Purchase for underage sales in pubs – no offences in Blackwood

Late night refreshment test purchase operation to deal with fast food premises staying open late
