# 11. To Discuss letter received from Blackwood Little Theatre

The Clerk read the letter from Blackwood Little Theatre outlining their current problems with the building. The total cost of the roof project is in the region of £48k, with £30k grant secured from Caerphilly C.B.C. Regeneration Fund and approx £11k raised in the last 3 weeks from a high profile fund raising campaign. Unfortunately a number of other issues have come to light, the most pressing being repair to an external wall causing serious damp problems and which left unchecked may pose a threat to the structural stability – these works estimated between £10k - £15k.

After much discussion, where members applauded the work of the Little Theatre over the past 70 years and the sterling efforts of the fund raising to date, they were adamant in their wish to support the group.

The Clerk reported that it seemed likely certain provisions made within the accounts for last year would not now materialise, in effect increasing balances by approx £1,000. After a little further discussion, it was *unanimously agreed* that a grant of £1,000 be awarded to Blackwood Little Theatre. It was also *agreed* that members of Blackwood Little Theatre be invited along to the next Policy & Finance Committee to explore any other possible additional assistance that might ensure the future of building.

#### 12. Libanus Primary School – Community Governor Vacancy

The Clerk reported on an e-mail received from the Governor Support Team which identified that Councillor C Erasmus term of Office as a Community Governor appointed by the Town Council had ended on 11<sup>th</sup>. June 2016.

It was *resolved* Councillor C Erasmus be re-nominated as the Town Council's Community Governor at Libanus Primary School.

#### 13. Verbal Report on Carnival

The Chair, Councillor Z Hammond reported that the Carnival had gone without any major hitches, and that the vast majority of feedback had been positive.

She placed on record her thanks to the Clerk for all his hard work, members who assisted on the day and to Sarah-Kate Ackerman ( Caerphilly C.B.C. ) and Ruth Stockley ( Local Churches Group ).

Rather than engage in any discussion on the event, it was agreed a Meeting of the Events Committee be called next week for a De- Brief on the Carnival.
